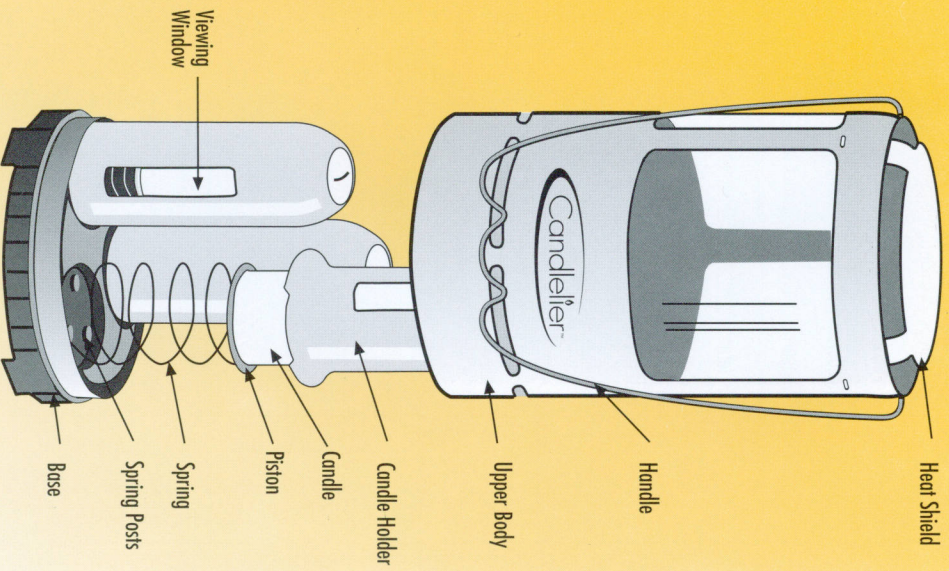
How to Light the Lantern

The American-made Candlerier lantern is ready for immediate use. To light it, remove the upper body from the candle assembly by turning the base clockwise. Light all three candles or as many as you'd like. After lighting, insert and lock back into the original position. As the lantern heats up, avoid touching the heat shield. A unique spring loaded candle holder keeps the flame height constant, while a small viewing window in candle holder shows the amount of candle remaining. Each candle will burn for approximately nine hours.

UCO candles have been engineered specifically for maximum performance and safety in UCO lanterns. The wick size and wax formula provide proper flame height and dripless burning.

Replacing Candles

Replacing the Candlerier's candles is easy. Open the lantern as described above. Then, hold the black base in a fixed position and unscrew one candle holder in a counter clockwise direction. Clean away any excess wax* and insert a new candle. If a spring becomes unattached, press the end of the spring around the

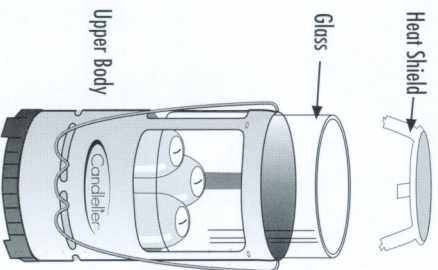


outside of the three spring posts. Place the piston against the bottom of the new candle and, compressing the spring against the piston, replace the candle holder onto the base by turning clockwise. Insert the base back into the upper body and twist to lock in place.

*Excess wax can be removed by chipping or scraping it off with a blunt object. This is easier if you can first place the part with the wax in the freezer for 10 to 20 minutes, or longer if needed. Wax can also be removed by heating it just enough to cause melting and blotting it with absorbent material.

Replacing Glass

To replace the lantern glass, remove the three heat shield legs from the upper body. A small screwdriver, or like object may be used. The glass will then slide upward and out for easy replacement. If the glass is broken, use extra caution when removing broken pieces.



The package containing your lantern was specially designed for reuse. Allow time for a recently used lantern to cool off before storing in the protective package.

Try the Lantern as a Stove



The heat shield of the Candlel lantern provides a stove-like surface to boil small amounts of water, melt snow or keep foods and beverages warm.



Use with Caution

The heat shield on top of the lantern is extremely hot during operation, and remains its heat even after the flame is extinguished. Ensure that you provide adequate distance between the lit lantern and any flammable or meltable materials. Fabrics can melt or ignite, even if treated with the retardant chemicals.

Store your lantern and spare candles in a cool place to prevent melting of wax. Protect your lantern from impacts and dropping that may cause the glass chimney to break. If your glass chimney breaks, use extreme caution when removing broken pieces. Never leave a burning candle unattended. Keep burning lantern away from children and pets.
